Formations Fund Act

The UADC Formation Fund will be regulated according to this act.

1. Purposes of the Formation Fund

- 1.1. To improve and enhance the level of visibility and involvement of the T.A. corps.
- 1.2. To raise the level of dancing and confidence, and team cohesion of the Teaching Assistants.
- 1.3. To encourage other members to aspire to become Teaching Assistants.
- 1.4 To improve and enhance the level of visibility of the UADC through promotional performances

2. Authority

2.1. The Instruction Board is responsible for the allocation of Formation funds, subject to the approval of the Executive Council.

3. Eligibility

3.1. Only Teaching Assistants are eligible for Formation funding.

4. Funding

- 4.1. The Executive will set the dollar limit of the Formation Fund in the annual budget.
- 4.2. A person or group may receive funding a maximum of 1 time per year for Formation fees/purchases.
- 4.3. Requests for funding must be submitted in writing to the VP Internal.
- 4.4. Requests for funding will be considered with the provision that the recipient is a member in good standing of the formations team in the order that they are received.
- 4.5. Recipients must submit their intentions and proof of the purchase being used for the formations team to the Treasurer in order to receive funds.

5. Types of Funding

- 5.1. Operational expenses
 - 5.1.1. Location bookings and the employment of an executive-approved dance/choreography instructor.
