Social Events Act

To provide our members with an opportunity to practice and enjoy the art of dance, social events will be held in accordance with this act.

1. Socials

- 1.1 Frequency: approx. 2 per dance session or 6 to 8 per year
- 1.2 Location: One to be held at Dinwoodie Lounge each academic semester if available
- 1.3 Logistics: To be organized by the Social Committee
- 1.4 Names: To be decided by the Social Director

2. Dances

- 2.1 Frequency: once for Halloween & once for Valentines
- 2.2 Location: St. John's if available
- 2.3 Logistics: To be organized by the Social Committee
- 2.4 Names: Halloween & Valentines

3. Balls/Formals

- 3.1 Frequency: near the conclusion of fall and winter academic sessions
- 3.2 Location: Shaw Conference Centre or Northlands Agricom or other suitable locations as recommended by the social Director and Social Committee.
- 3.3 Logistics: To be organized by the Social Committee
- 3.4 Names: Winter Waltz (fall session) & Top Hat and Tails (winter session)

4. Budgeting

- 4.1 Items set by the Executive in the budget
 - 4.1.1 Ticket prices
 - 4.1.2 Number of people predicted for budgeting purposes
 - 4.1.3 Subsidy or profit to be made by event (bottom line)
- 4.2 Although the UADC budget contains suggested guidelines, the social committees may rearrange their budgets on an event by event basis, excluding the items enumerated in 4.1 as they deem appropriate.
- 4.3 Budget surpluses (if any) are returned to the general revenues of the UADC

5. Ticket Sales

5.1 All socials, dances and balls/formals will be open to the general public as well as UADC members, unless the social coincides with the Annual General Elections.

6. Dates

6.1 Dates for all events will be set by the executive in the UADC annual calendar.
